

WAR SERVICE CHEVRONS

The Ministry of Home Security and the Scottish Office state that the following additions have been made to the list of local authority services eligible for the award of war service chevrons and wound stripes:—Rest centre services; emergency food services, including Queen's Messenger Convoy Service; canteen service; emergency information service; and mortuary service.

Members in these services will be eligible only if they have, during the period in question, been engaged in a section of the services which function operationally during, or immediately after, enemy attacks.

Persons who have retired or have been discharged from the Police, the Civil Defence general services, National Fire Service, and fire guards are qualified for war service chevrons or wound stripes for the period during which they were members of the eligible service.
